For example, the questions for “Who?” could include:

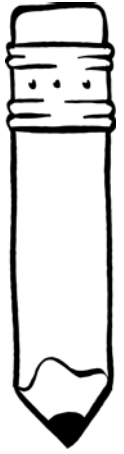
- Who is preaching?



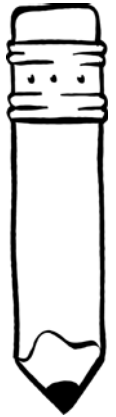

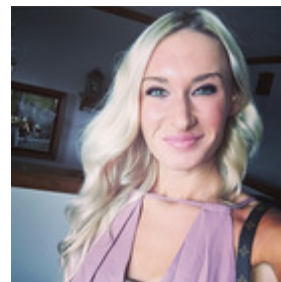
