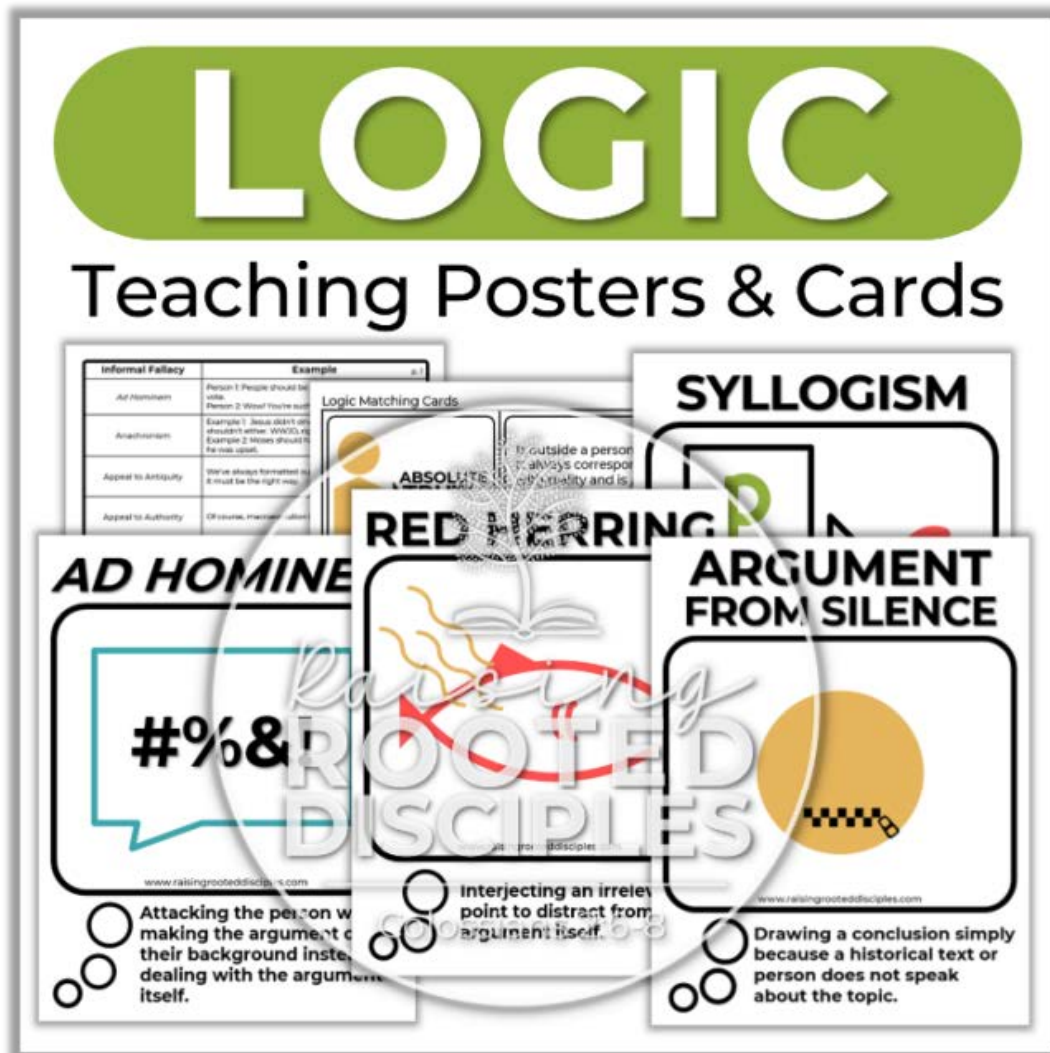

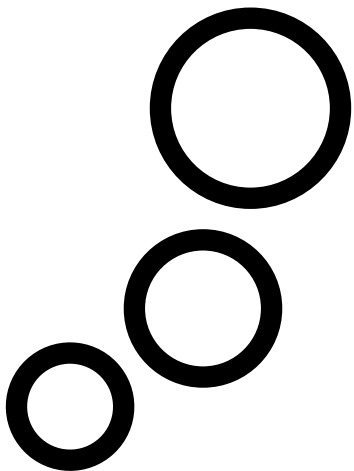

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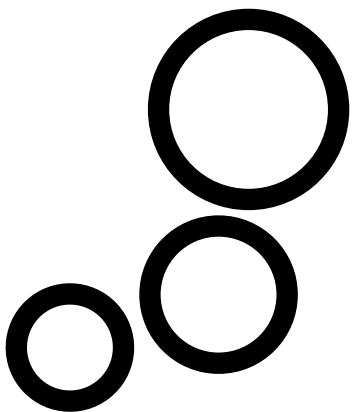
Attacking the person who is making the argument or their background instead of dealing with the argument itself.

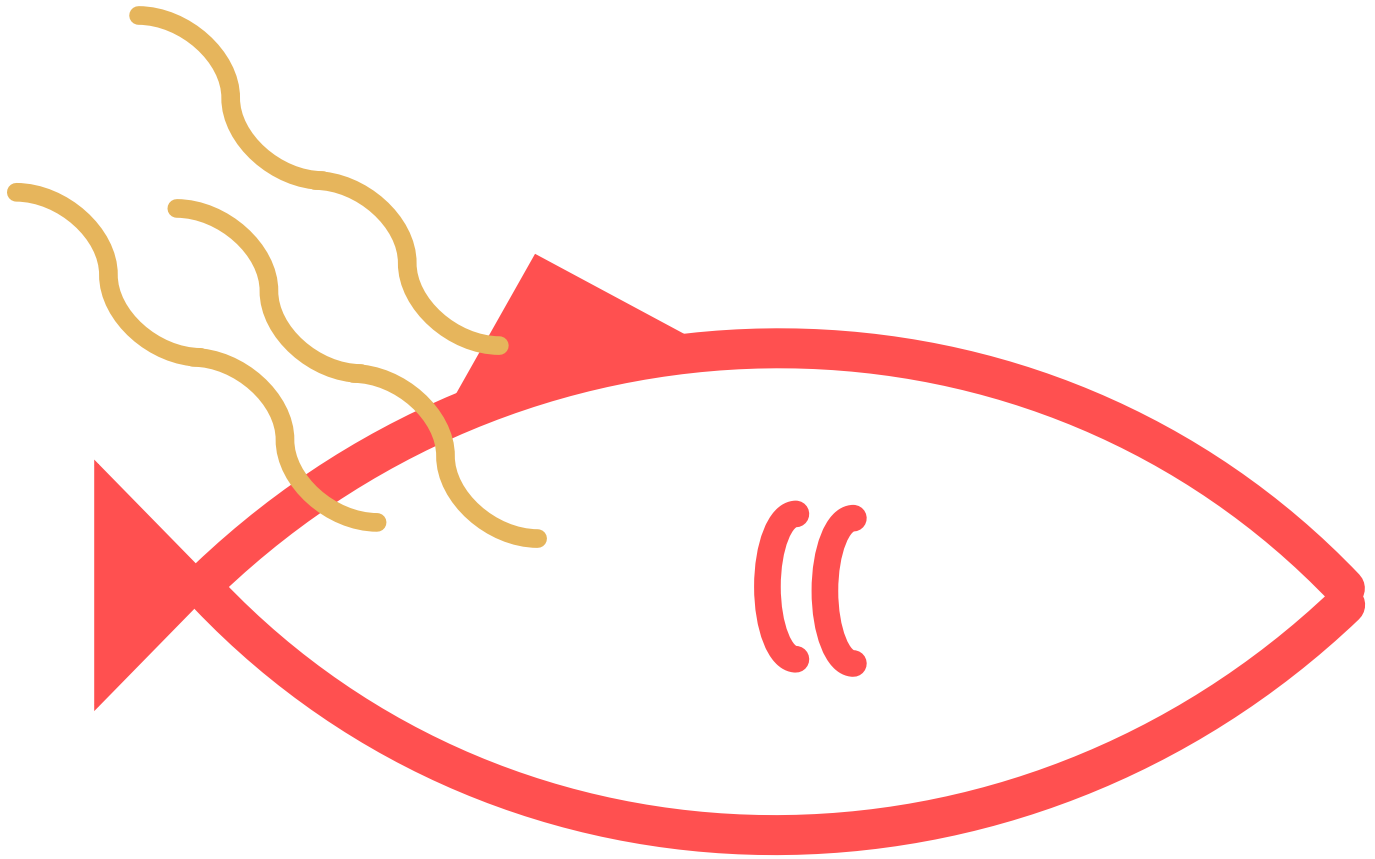
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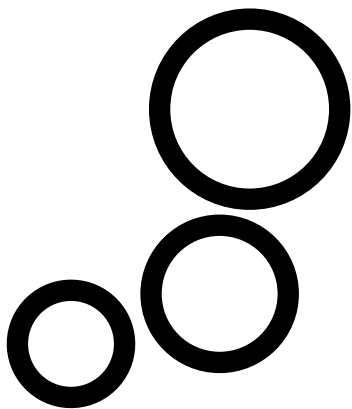


Quoting someone out of context from what they originally said in a way that distorts their message.

RED HERRING

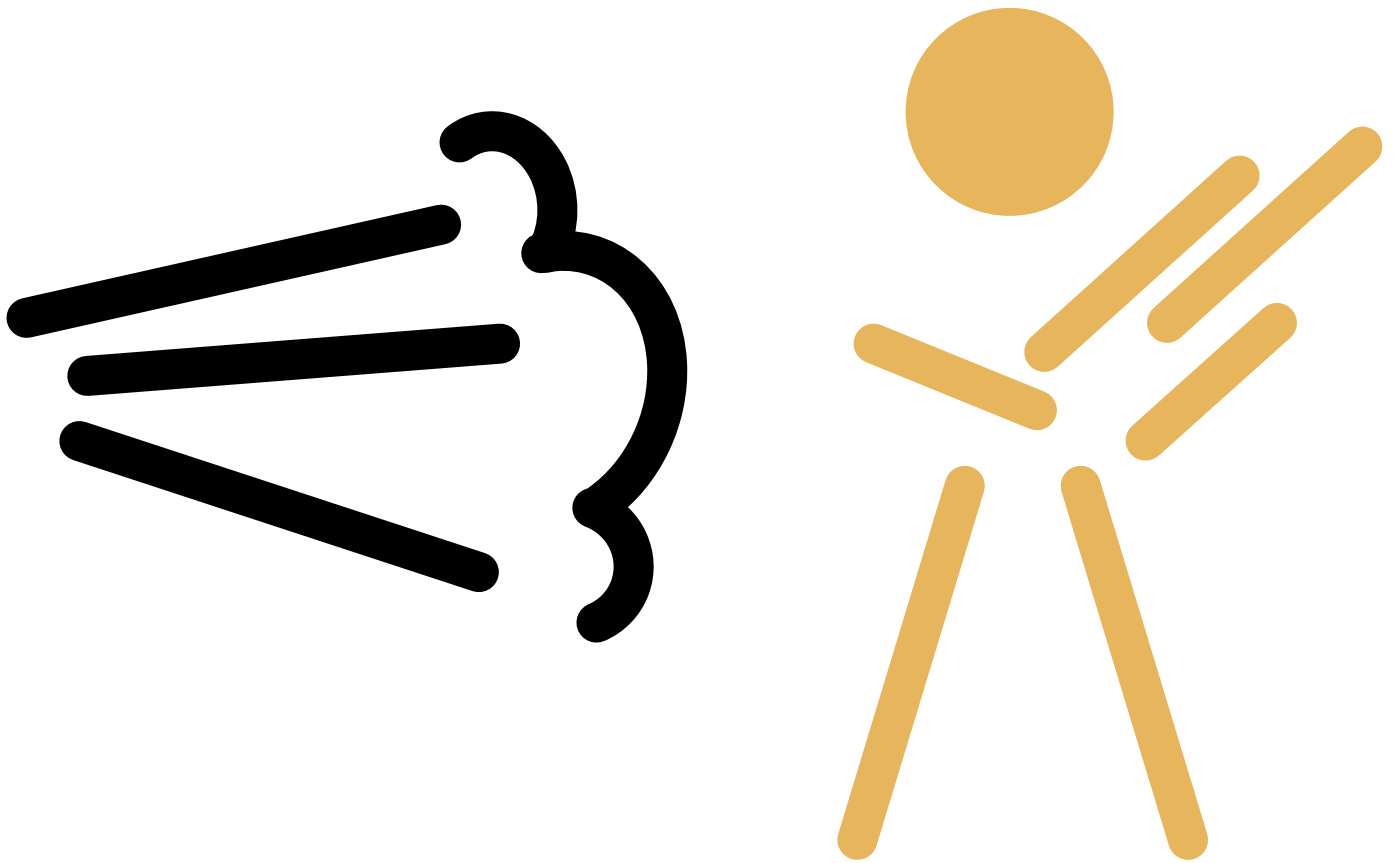


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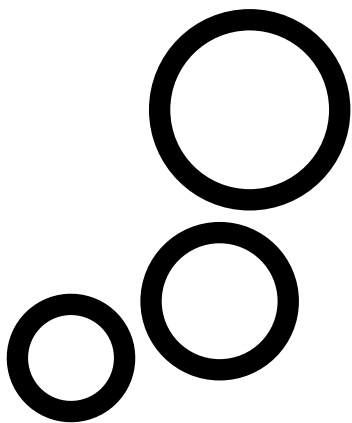


Interjecting an irrelevant point to distract from the argument itself.

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Creating a false picture of the opposing argument to make it easier to blow or knock down.

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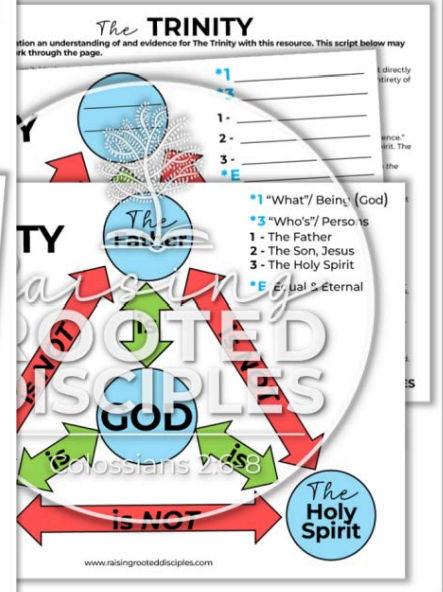
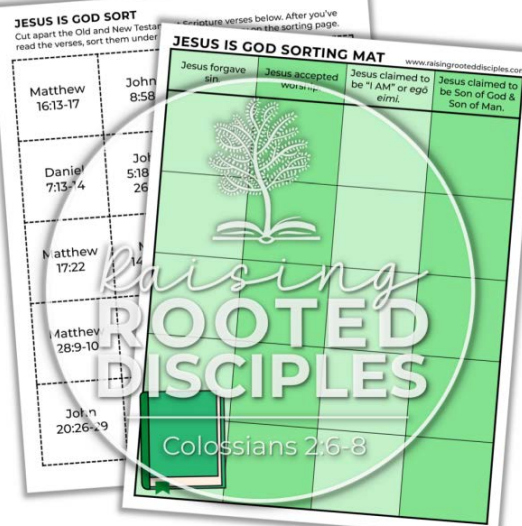
